Count: 32 **Wall:** 2 **Level:** Easy Intermediate

Choreographer: Jan Wyllie , Hervey Bay, Qld., Australia (Jan 2007)

Music: Would You Catch A Falling Star by John Anderson (104 bpm)

Intro: 16 count intro start on word 'small'

Step Scuff, Shuffle Fwd, 4 Count Rocking Chair

- 1,2** Step fwd on L, Scuff R fwd
- 3&4** Shuffle fwd R,L,R
- 5,6,7,8** Rock/step fwd on L, Rock back on R, Rock/step back on L, Rock fwd on R

Step Fwd Scuff, Step Across Back, Step To Side Scuff, Step Across Back

- 9,10,11,12** Step fwd on L, Scuff R across L, Step R across L, Step back on L
- 13,14,15,16** Step R to right side, Scuff L across R, Step L across R, Step back on R

Side Rock Return, Cross Shuffle, Side Rock Return, Cross Shuffle

- 17,18** Rock/step L to left side, Rock/return wt sideways onto R
- 19&20** Cross/shuffle right stepping L,R,L
- 21,22** Rock/step R to right side, Rock/return wt sideways onto L
- 23&24** Cross/shuffle left stepping R,L,R

Side Touch, 1/4 Monterey Turn, Side Touch, 1/4 Monterey Turn

- 25,26** Step L to left side, Touch R beside L
- 27,28** Touch R toe to right side, Making 1/4 right step R beside L (Monterey)
- 29,30** Touch L toe to left side, Step L beside R
- 31,32** Touch R toe to right side, Making 1/4 right step R beside L

This is an easy dance to a nice slow song.

Although the steps are easy, the dance is still too hard for A beginner dancer because there is a trick or two to keep it interesting.
