

ROULETTE

Music: If It Will It Will by Hank Williams Jr.

This is a traveling line dance done in a circle around the outer perimeter of the dance floor with all dancers facing center. It is also very similar, if not identical to a dance called "Traveling Chicago 4-Step" and to another one called "Redneck Girl." If there are enough people, try forming a second circle inside the first one but facing out. As many circles within circles can be formed as there are people and as the dance floor allows. If the dancers agree to follow one leader, this dance can be done as a "snake" line weaving around the room.

HEEL TOUCHES

- 1-2 Touch left heel forward; return beside right
- 3-4 Touch left heel forward; return beside right
- 5 Touch left heel forward

LEFT VINE

- 6-7 Step left foot to left side; cross-step right behind left
- 8-9 Step left foot to left side; kick right foot forward

RIGHT VINE WITH ½ TURN

- 10-11 Step right foot to right side; cross-step left behind right
- 13-14 Step right foot to right side; turning ½ right, kick left foot forward

LEFT VINE. WITH ½ TURN

- 15-16 Step left foot to left side; cross-step right behind left
- 17& Step left foot to left side; turn ½ left

RIGHT VINE

- 18-19 Step right foot to right side; cross-step left behind right
- 20 Step right foot to right side

REPEAT
