## RIGHT SCISSOR - LEFT SCISSOR

- 1-2 Right side step, recover Left
- 3-4 Cross Right over left, Hold
- 5-6 Left side step, recover Right
- 7-8 Cross Left over right, Hold

## BOX RIGHT - BOX LEFT 1/4 TURN

- 1-2 Right side step, Left together
- 3-4 Right step back, (left)Hold
- 5-6 Left step 1/4 turn(left), Right together
- 7-8 Left step forward, (right)Hold

## RIGHT SCISSOR - LEFT SCISSOR

- 1-2 Right side step, recover Left
- 3-4 Cross Right over left, Hold
- 5-6 Left side step, recover Right
- 7-8 Cross Left over right, Hold

## BOX RIGHT - BOX LEFT 1/4 TURN

- 1-2 Right side step, Left together
- 3-4 Right step back, (left)Hold
- 5-6 Left step 1/4 turn(left), Right together
- 7-8 Left step forward, (right)Hold

## LOCK STEPS RIGHT - LOCK STEPS LEFT

- 1-2 Step Right forward, Lock Left behind Right
- 3-4 Step Right forward, Hold
- 5-6 Step Left forward. Lock Right behind Left

7-8 Step Left forward, Hold 2(two)-

### **JAZZ BOXES with 1/4 TURNS (right)**

1-2 Cross Right over Left, Left step back

3-4 Step Right 1/4 Turn (right), Left together

5-6 Cross Right over Left, Left step back

7-8 Step Right 1/4 Turn (right), Left together

### **LOCK STEPS RIGHT - LOCK STEP LEFT**

1-2 Step Right forward, Lock Left behind Right

3-4 Step Right forward, Hold

5-6 Step Left forward, Lock Right behind Left

7-8 Step Left forward, Hold 2(two)

### **JAZZ BOXES with 1/4 TURNS(right)**

1-2 Cross Right over Left, Left step back

3-4 Step Right 1/4 Turn (right), Left together

5-6 Cross Right over Left, Left step back

7-8 Step Right 1/4 Turn (right), Left together

### **E. O. D.**

**\*NOTE\* = TAG after Second (2) and Fourth (4) Walls only.**

### **Tag Steps (Basic 8 count)**

1-2 Side step Right, Left together

3-4 Side step Right, Left together

5-6 Side step Left, Right together

7-8 Side step Left, Right together
