Music: Window On The World by Jimmy Buffett

¼ LEFT, HOLD, RIGHT-LEFT-SIDE RIGHT, HOLD, TOGETHER-SIDE RIGHT, COASTER FORWARD

- 1 With weight on right, pivot ¼ turn left, stepping on left (9:00)
- 2 Hold
- 3&4 Step right beside left, step left beside right, step to right on right
- 5 Hold
- &6 Step left beside right, step to right on right
- 7&8 Step forward on left, step right beside left, step back on left

CROSS RIGHT, STEP LEFT, BEHIND-SIDE-CROSS, STEP LEFT, SLIDE RIGHT TO LEFT, HOLD, ROCK BACK RIGHT, CROSS LEFT

- 1-2 Cross right over left, step left on left
- 3&4 Cross right behind left, step left to left, cross right over left
- 5-7 Step large step left on left, slide right to left (slowly)
- &8 Rock back on ball of right, cross left over right

BACK RIGHT, ½ TURN LEFT, SYNCOPATED ROCKING CHAIRS, TOUCH, SWAY RIGHT & LEFT

- 1 Step back on right
- 2 Pivot ½ turn left on right, stepping forward left (3:00)
- 3&4&5&6 Rock forward on right, rock center on left, rock back on right, rock center on left, rock forward on right, rock center on left, touch right beside left
- 7-8 Sway right on right, sway left on left

¼ TURN LEFT, COASTER BACK, ¼ COASTER TURN LEFT, SYNCOPATED WEAVE RIGHT

- 1-2 Step forward on right, pivot ¼ turn left, holding weight on right (12:00)
- 3&4 Step back on left, step right beside left, step forward on left
- 5&6 Step back on right, pivot ¼ turn left stepping on left, step right to right (9:00)

&7&8 Step left behind right, step right on right, cross left over right, step right on right

REPEAT

RESTART

On the 4th and 8th repetitions of the dance, the song has only 30 counts (during the instrumental portion) before starting a new verse. Therefore, on the 4th and 8th walls, dance through counts 5 & 6 of the 4th phrase (counts 29 & 30), then restart the dance on count 1.
