Rocking Chair, Scuff

9RF rock forward

10LF rock back

11RF rock forward

12LF scuff

Pivot, Step, Scuff

13LF step forward

14 1/2 turn R

15LF step forward

16RF scuff

Right Turning Vine, 1/2 Turn

17RF step side

18LF cross behind

19RF step forward 1/4 turn R

Back Shuffle, Back Rock Step

Triple Turn, Back Rock Step

25LF step side, 1/4 turn R

& RF step beside

27RF rock back

28LF rock forward

Electric Kick

29RF rock forward

32LF rock forward

RESTART: Dance during round 3 till count 32 and start over

Heel Switches, Hold (Clap)

33RF touch heel forward

& RF step beside

34LF touch heel forward

& LF step beside

35RF touch heel forward

36hold (clap)

& RF step beside

37LF touch heel forward

& LF step beside

38RF touch heel forward

& RF step beside

39LF touch hee forward

40hold (clap)

Left Vine, Touch (Clap)

41LF step side

42RF cross behind

44RF touch beside (clap)

Right Rolling Turn, Touch (Clap)

45RF step forward 1/4 turn R

46LF step back 1/2 turn R
