

# Three Teardrops (aka Roger's Waltz)

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**Count:** 48      **Wall:** 2      **Level:** Upper Beginner

**Choreographer:** Chiew Patricia (Singapore), June 2015

**Music:** Blue Side of Lonesome by Jim Reeves

## Choreographer's Note:

I had specially choreographed this line dance entitled "THREE TEARDROPS aka ROGER'S WALTZ" in memory of ROGER PHOON, a very good friend who had left us on 15 June 2015. Roger loved line dancing, especially to the waltz music, and was always dressed smartly in his cowboy attire.

**Intro: 12 Counts (Start dancing on vocal)**

### [1-6] L FWD ½ L TURN, ON THE SPOT R AND L, R BACK, ON THE SPOT L AND R

**1-3** Step L fwd into ½ left turn, step R next to L, step L next to R

**4-6** Step back on R, step L next to R, step R next to L

### [7-12] L FWD ¼ L TURN, ON THE SPOT R AND L, R BACK, ON THE SPOT L AND R

**1-3** Step L fwd into ¼ left turn, step R next to L, step L next to R

**4-6** Step back on R, step L next to R, step R next to L

### [13-18] L CROSS, SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE ROCK R-L-R

**1-3** Cross L over R, step R next to L, step L behind R

**4-6** Side rock R, L, R

### [19-24] L CROSS, SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE ROCK R-L-R

**1-3** Cross L over R, step R next to L, step L behind R

**4-6** Side rock R, L, R

### [25-30] L FWD ¼ L TURN, ON THE SPOT R AND L, R BACK, ON THE SPOT L AND R

**1-3** Step L fwd into ¼ left turn, step R next to L, step L next to R

**4-6** Step back on R, step L next to R, step R next to L

### [31-36] LEFT TWINKLE, RIGHT TWINKLE

**1-3** Cross L over R, step R on R, step L on L

**4-6** Cross R over L, step L on L, step R on R

**[37-42] L FWD 1/4 L TURN, ON THE SPOT R AND L, R TO R, SLIDE L NEXT TO R**

**1-3** Step L fwd into  $\frac{1}{4}$  left turn, step R next to L, step L next to R

**4-6** Step R to R, slide L next to R (on 2 counts)

**[43-48] LEFT BACK, ON THE SPOT R AND L,  $\frac{1}{4}$  L TURN R BACK, SLIDE L NEXT TO R**

**1-3** Step back on L, step R next to L, step L next to R

**4-6** Step R back into  $\frac{1}{4}$  L turn, slide L next R (on 2 counts)

**START AGAIN**

**Ending: For the last 4-6 counts (ie Counts 46-48)**

**Step into  $\frac{1}{4}$  R to R, slide L next to R (on 2 counts)**

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
