Music: Down to the Honkytonk -Jake Owen

#32 count Intro. No Tags or restarts

[1-8] K step (optional claps on touches)

1-4R fwd to right diagonal, touch L, L back, touch R, R

5-8 Step R back on diagonal, touch L beside, Step L fwd diagonal, touch R beside

[9-16] Vine x2 with touches, 1/4 turn

1-4 Step R to right side, Step L behind, Step R to right side, Touch L beside

5-6 Step L to left side, Step R behind L, Step L to left side, ¼ turn left (9.00)

[17-24] Fwd Lock step scuff x2

1-4R step fwd, Step L behind right heel, Step R fwd, scuff L

5-8 Step L fwd, Step R behind left heel, Step L fwd, scuff R

[25-32] Rock recover, 1/2 turn, 1/2 turn lock back

1-4R rock (1), recover (2), 1/2 right turn (3), hold (4) (3.00)

5-8 Step L Fwd 1/4 turn (5), Cross R over L 1/8 turn (6), step back L 1/8 turn square up to face wall (7), hold (8) (9.00),

[33-40] R side rock cross, hold, L side rock cross hold

1-4 Rock R, recover, cross R over L, hold,

5-8 Rock L, recover, cross L over R, hold

[41-48] R Rumba box with touches

1-4R to right side, L beside, R fwd, L touch beside R

5-8L to left side, R beside, L back, R touch beside L

[49-56] Monterey 1/4 turn, Jazz box

1-4R point to side, turn $\frac{1}{4}$ transferring weight to R, point L to left side, bring L down beside R

5-8cross R over L, small step back L, Step R to right side L, L fwd beside R (12.00)

[57-64] Heel, Hook, Fwd Tap, Tekapo Twist

1-4R Heel (1), R hook (2), R forward (3), L tap behind R (4)

5-6L step back (5), R cross L angling body to 10.30 (6), ($\frac{1}{2}$ over counts 6 &7)

7-8 Finish turn in place keeping weight on L (7), R touch beside L (8) (6.00)

Finish: On Counts 6 & 7 of Tekapo twist turn to face the front
