RIGHT LOCK STEP FORWARD, TAP LEFT BEHIND, STEP BACK LEFT, RIGHT HEEL, STEP FORWARD RIGHT, TAP LEFT BEHIND

1-4R step forward, step R behind, step R, tap R behind R

5-8 Step back L, L heel forward, Step forward R, Tap R behind R

LEFT LOCK STEP BACK, HEEL RIGHT, STEP FORWARD RIGHT, LEFT TOE BEHIND, STEP BACK LEFT RIGHT

1-4 Step back L, L beside L, step back L, heel L at the R toe

5-8 Step forward R, toe R behind L heel, step back L, step L together

STEP LEFT PIVOT $\frac{1}{2}$ RIGHT, STEP FORWARD LEFT PIVOT $\frac{1}{4}$ RIGHT WITH RIGHT HITCH, SHUFFLE FORWARD 2X

1-4 Step R forward, pivot $\frac{1}{2}$ R, step forward L, pivot $\frac{1}{4}$ R, with L hitch

5&6 Shuffle forward RLR

7&8 Shuffle forward LRL

STEP RIGHT FORWARD, PIVOT $\frac{1}{2}$ LEFT, SHUFFLE FORWARD, LEFT HEEL, RIGHT HEEL, LEFT HEEL SCUFF RIGHT

1-2 Step L forward, pivot $\frac{1}{2}$ L

3&4 Shuffle forward RLR

5&6L heel and L heel

&7&8 And R heel, and scuff R

This particular music calls for a tag, however, most beginner dancers are unlikely to notice.

This dance can also be done to other Irish Jigs.
