**Choreographer:** Matt & LeeAnne Oakley (Jan 11)

**Music:** Come On Get Higher by Matt Nathanson (92bpm)

**[1-8] 2 Walks, Mambo Fwd, Step Back, ½ Turn, 1¼ Triple Turn**

**1RF start to step forward**

**&RF step down**

**2LF step forward**

**3RF rock forward**

**&LF recover**

**4RF step back**

**5LF step back**

**6RF ½ turn right step forward**

**7LF step next to RF ¾ turn right**

**&RF ¼ turn right step forward**

**8LF ¼ turn right step side left (9:00)**

**[9-16] Heel Ball Cross, Rock, Recover, Cross, ¼ Turn Rock, Recover, Walk Back X2, ½ Turn Step Fwd**

**1RF with toe on floor tap heel diagonally right forward**

**&RF step on ball closer to LF**

**2LF cross over RF**

**3RF rock side right**

**&LF recover**

**4RF cross over LF**

**5LF  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn left rock forward (6:00)**

**6RF recover**

**7LF step back**

**8RF step back**

**&LF  $\frac{1}{2}$  turn left step forward (12:00)**

**[17-24] Large Step Forward, Drag, Cross-Out-Out X2 Traveling Back, Step Fwd,  $\frac{3}{4}$  Turn Sweep**

**1RF large step forward**

**2LF drag to RF**

**3LF cross over RF**

**&RF step side and slightly back**

**4LF step side and slightly back**

**5RF cross over LF**

**&LF step side and slightly back**

**6RF step side and slightly back**

**7LF step forward**

**8LF  $\frac{3}{4}$  turn left sweep RF back to front (3:00)**

**[25-32] Step Fwd,  $\frac{1}{2}$  Turn, 2 Walks, Rock, Recover, Cross, Walk Around**

**1RF step forward**

**2LF  $\frac{1}{2}$  turn left step forward (9:00)**

**3RF step forward**

**4LF step forward**

**&RF rock side right and slightly forward**

**5LF recover**

**6RF cross over LF**

**7LF 1/8 turn right step forward (10:30)**

**&RF 3/8 turn right cross in front of LF (3:00)**

**8LF step side left and slightly forward**
