**This dance is done in FOUR directions.**

**Introduction : 12 Beats - Original Position: Feet Together Weight On The Left Foot.**

## **S1: RUMBA FORWARD, HOLD, RUMBA BACK, HOLD**

- 1, 2      Step R To The Side, Step L Together,
- 3, 4      Step R Forward, Hold,
- 5, 6      Step L To The Side, Step R Together,
- 7, 8      Step L Back, Hold.

## **S2: BACK, LOCK, BACK, HOLD, BACK, ROCK, FORWARD, HOLD**

- 1, 2      Step R Back, Lock L Across In Front Of Right,
- 3, 4      Step R Back, Hold,
- 5, 6      Step L Back, Rock Forward Onto R,
- 7, 8      Step L Forward, Hold.

## **S3: FORWARD, LOCK, FORWARD, HOLD, PADDLE TURN, ACROSS, HOLD**

- 1, 2      Step R Forward, Lock L Behind Right,
- 3, 4      Step R Forward, Hold,
- 5, 6      Paddle : Step L Forward, Turn 90° Right Take Weight Onto R,
- 7, 8      Step L Across In Front Of Right, Hold.

## **S4: SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, ACROSS, SIDE, ROCK, ACROSS, HOLD**

- 1, 2      Step R To The Side, Step L Behind Right,
- 3, 4      Step R To The Side, Step L Across In Front Of Right,
- 5, 6      Step R To The Side, Side Rock Onto L,
- 7, 8      Step R Across In Front Of Left, Hold.

## **S5: SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, ACROSS, SIDE, ROCK, ACROSS, HOLD**

- 1, 2** Step L To The Side, Step R Behind Left,  
**3, 4** Step L To The Side, Step R Across In Front Of Left,  
**5, 6** Step L To The Side, Side Rock Onto R,  
**7, 8** Step L Across In Front Of Right, Hold.

**S6: SIDE, ROCK, ACROSS, HOLD, SIDE, ROCK ACROSS, HOLD**

- 1, 2** Step R To The Side, Side Rock Onto L,  
**3, 4** Step R Across In Front Of Left, Hold,  
**5, 6** Step L To The Side, Side Rock Onto R,  
**7, 8** Step L Across In Front Of Right, Hold

**[48] REPEAT THE DANCE IN NEW DIRECTION**
