

# How A Cowgirl Says Goodbye

## **[1-8] SIDE TOGETHER, SHUFFLE 1/4 TURN RIGHT, ROCK RECOVER, SHUFFLE 1/2 TURN LEFT**

**1-2** Step right foot to right side, step left next to right.

**3&4** Shuffle ¼ turn right stepping right, left, right.

**5-6** Rock forward on left, recover on right.

**7&8** Shuffle ½ turn left stepping left, right, left.

## **[9-16] PIVOT 1/4 TURN LEFT, CROSSING SHUFFLE, SIDE ROCK RECOVER, CROSSING SHUFFLE**

**1-2** Step forward right, pivot ¼ turn left.

**3&4** Cross right over left, step left to left side, cross right over left.

**5-6** Rock left foot out to left side, recover on right.

**7&8** Cross left over right, step right to right side, cross left over right.

## **[17-24] STEP 1/4 TURN RIGHT AS YOU WALK, WALK, COASTER STEP, WALK BACK, WALK BACK, SHUFFLE 1/2 TURN LEFT**

**1-2** Step forward on right foot as you make a ¼ turn right, step forward left.

**3&4** Step forward right, step left next to right, step back on right.

**5-6** Walk back two steps, left and right.

**7&8** Shuffle ½ turn left stepping left, right, left.

## **\*Restart the dance here during the fourth revolution**

## **[25-32] STEP POINT, STEP POINT, JAZZ BOX 1/4 TURN RIGHT W/CROSS**

**1-2** Step forward right, point left foot to left side.

**3-4** Step forward left, point right foot to right side.

**5-8** Cross right over left, step back on left, step ¼ right with right foot, cross left over right.

**\*RESTART: During the fourth revolution you will be starting the dance to the 6 o'clock wall. After 24 counts, restart the dance to the 9 o'clock wall instead of 12 o'clock.**
