Count: 32 **Wall:** 2 **Level:** Beginner

Music: Lieblingsmensch by Namika

Intro: Start on Lyrics

[1-8] ROCKING CHAIR, STEP, TAP, STEP BACK, KICK

- 1 - 2 Rock right forward, recover weight to left
- 3 - 4 Rock right back, recover weight to left
- 5 - 6 Step right forward, tap left behind right (Angle slightly left when you tap)
- 7 - 8 Step left back, kick right forward

[9 - 16] 1/4 RIGHT, BALANCE STEPS RIGHT & LEFT, SIDE, TOGETHER, SIDE, BRUSH

- 1 - 2 Turn 1/4 right stepping right to side, touch left beside right
- 3 - 4 Step left to side, touch right beside left
- 5 - 6 Step right to side, step left beside right
- 7 - 8 Step right to side, brush left

[17 - 24] CROSS ROCK, RECOVER, 1/2 TURN LEFT, BRUSH, VINE RIGHT WITH TAP

- 1 - 2 Rock left across right, recover weight to right
- 3 - 4 Turn 1/4 left (Stepping forward with left), Turn 1/4 left brushing right beside left
- 5 - 6 Step right to side, cross left behind right
- 7 - 8 Step right to side, tap left next to right (no weight on left)

[25 - 32] LEFT SIDE SISSORS, HOLD, 1/8 TURN HIP SWIVELS (X2)

- 1 - 2 Step left to side, step right beside left
- 3 - 4 Cross left over right, hold
- 5 - 6 Step right forward , pivot 1/8 left
- 7 - 8 Step right forward , pivot 1/8 left

REPEAT

EASY TAG - Very obvious in the music.

*** After the 8th rotation, 5th time you start dance facing front (12:00 O'clock) the music stops. Add a 4 Count Rocking Chair before you begin the new wall.**

(You will be doing 2 Rocking chairs in a row, the TAG and the first 4 counts of the dance)
