#16 count intro approx. 109 Bpm

Section 1: Right side Rock, recover. Right Cross shuffle. $\frac{1}{4}$ Turn, step. Left cross shuffle

- 1 - 2 Rock Right to right side, recover onto Left
- 3 & 4 Cross Right over Left. Step Left to left side. Cross Right over Left
- 5 - 6 Make $\frac{1}{4}$ turn right stepping Left back. Step Right to right side 3.00
- 7 & 8 Cross Left over Right. Step Right to right side. Cross Left over Right

Section 2: Charleston kicks x 2

- 1-2-3-4 Step forward Right. Kick Left forward, step back on Left, touch Right toe back
- 5-6-7-8 Step forward Right. Kick Left forward, step back on Left, touch Right toe back

Section 3: Right side Rock, recover. Right Cross shuffle. $\frac{1}{4}$ Turn, step. Left cross shuffle

- 1 - 2 Rock Right to right side, recover onto Left
- 3 & 4 Cross Right over Left. Step Left to left side. Cross Right over Left
- 5 - 6 Make $\frac{1}{4}$ turn right stepping Left back. Step Right to right side 6.00
- 7 & 8 Cross Left over Right. Step Right to right side. Cross Left over Right

Section 4: Charleston kicks x 2

- 1-2-3-4 Step forward Right. Kick Left forward, step back on Left, touch Right toe back
- 5-6-7-8 Step forward Right. Kick Left forward, step back on Left, touch Right toe back

Section 5: Tap, hitch, cross shuffle. Side chasse, back rock, recover

- 1 - 2 Tap Right toe, hitch Right foot
- 3 & 4 Cross Right over Left, step Left to side, cross Right over Left
- 5 & 6 Step Left to left side, close Right next to Left, step Left to left side

7 - 8 Rock Right back, recover onto Left

Section 6: Paddle 1/8 left x 2, Kickball change, rock, recover

1-2-3-4 Paddle turning 1/8 left, paddle turning 1/8 left 9.00

5 & 6 Kickball change

7 - 8 Rock Right forward, recover onto Left (weight on Left)
